Vote by Mail Application Instructions

For Voters 65 and Older

- **1. Voter Information:** Include full name, phone* and date of birth (other fields are optional)
- **2. Identification Numbers:** This has new instructions due to SB1 requirements, make sure to include:

Texas Driver's License # or other TX ID **AND**The last 4 digits of your Social Security Number

Provide **BOTH** numbers if you have them to avoid your application possibly being rejected.

If you don't have either of these numbers, contact Bexar County Elections at 210-335-VOTE

- 3. Residence address: Where you are registered to vote
- **4. Mailing address:** Same as residential is the most common. See instructions on application for other options
- **5. Reason for voting by mail:** 65 years or older. *See instructions on application if this does not apply.*
- **6. Send me ballots for the following elections:** Annual Application AND Democratic Primary AND Any Resulting Runoff
- **7. Assistant or Witness:** Required only if you need special assistance. See details on application
- 8. Voter Signature: Sign and date

After filling the application either TAPE the sides of the printed application form OR place in envelope. Mail to: **Early Voting Clerk 1103 S. Frio, SA TX 78207.** Affix a first-class postage stamp.
